

INSTRUCTION FOR AUTHORS:

Every abstract must contain:

1. Title, authors, authors affiliations (*Calibri, size 14, CapsLock*);
2. Corresponding author: first and last name, affiliation, e-mail address (*Calibri, size 12*)
3. Main text should be structured as (maximum 500 words, *Calibri, size 11*): Background and Aims, Material and Methods, Results, Conclusions.
4. Figures and Tables (maximum 2 elements): maximum 1 table and 1 figure, or maximum 2 tables and 0 figures, or maximum 2 figures and 0 tables.
5. Keywords (maximum 5) that will be listed in alphabetical order.
6. References: each abstract should contain 5 references (references style: 1. Author, A.B.; Author, C.D. Title of the article. Abbreviated Journal Name Year, Volume, page range). (*Calibri, size 10*)
